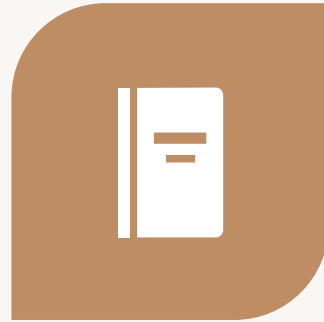


Why Manage Citations

What is a citation?

(BOOK, ARTICLE, CONFERENCE
PROCEEDING, GREY LITERATURE,
ETC)



TELLS OTHERS WHERE TO FIND
THE RESOURCE

USUAL FUNCTIONALITY

- Importing references from databases or the web
- Organizing and sharing with colleagues
- Reading and annotating full text
- Easily inserting into documents

UNIQUE FEATURES

- Plug-ins for Google Drive and Microsoft Word
- Great web importer for PDFs or webpages
- Easy-to-use annotation tool and note compilation feature
